- Collaborative Network in which Nebraska state, federal, nonprofit, and university stakeholders meet quarterly to discuss best practices, new initiatives, strategies, and programming
- Conference aimed at veterans

Overall Target Outcome

By the end of this project, we will have helped:

 3780 people (including 10% socially disadvantaged and 10% veterans) to take action, including 378 start a farm
