- Resists a major part of the job
- Doesn't respect others' time

- >> Need you to accept that your job includes ...
- Respect everyone's time by doing your prep in advance
- >> Prioritize w/more attention to overall goals.
- Show respect for your colleagues

Turnaround Examples





- Reactive
 - Proactive
- Late
 - On time
- Tasks take twice the time they should
 - Complete tasks in 1/2 the time...
- Excuse expert!
 - Put your energy into finding solutions...
- Makes assumptions
 - Make conclusions based on facts...

Turnaround Examples, cont.

- Does not dig into the difficult work
- Doesn't take responsibility for...
- Takes no ownership for...
- Can't let others finish their thoughts...
- Shows no consideration of the time limits we have
- Pays no attention to others' needs
