



Cucumbers

Friendly:

Celery, legumes -peas/beans, Dill, Corn, Radish, sunflowers, nasturtiums

Not Friendly:

Squash, pumpkins, and melons, potatoes, sage, brassicas, fennel



Peppers

Friendly:

Basil (herb varieties in the mint family), alliums types, carrots, chenopods family, okra, grass varieties (lemon grass, sorghum, corn), tomatoes, marigold, nasturtium,

Not Friendly:

Fennel, brassicas, beans/legumes



Turnips\ bulb\root
brassicas

Friendly:

Peas, bush beans, marigold, mint varieties,

Not Friendly:

Other root crops, potatoes

**Tomatoes and kohlrabi stunt each others growth

**minimize growing too many brassica types in one area



Leafy Brassica varieties

Friendly:

Chenopod varieties, cucumbers, Aster varieties, potato, Chamomile, alliums, mint varieties, nasturtiums, marigolds, thyme (most herbs), radish

Not Friendly:

Fennel

**minimize growing too many brassica types in one area



Beans

Friendly:

Bean, carrot, corn, cucumber, radish, turnip, chenopods variety, cabbage family, carrot, celery, corn, cucumber, eggplant, pea, potatoes, radish, strawberry, mint family, marigold, nasturtium

Not Friendly:

Alliums, Fennel



Beets/chenopods variety

Family members: Swiss Chard, spinach

Friendly:

Most cabbage family and onion, Bush beans, lettuce, strawberries, mint family (catnip- great against rodents, ground squirrels), marigold, nasturtium,

Not Friendly:

Pole beans, wild mustard/ field mustard



Melons

Friendly:

Corn, radish, marigold, nasturtiums, oregano, garlic, dill, mint varieties, broccoli

Not Friendly:

Sage potatoes, any other cucurbit families, potatoes and most of other solanaceae, most of aster families



Tomato/ groundcherries

Friendly:

Asparagus, carrot, celery, cucumber, onion, parsley, pepper, mint varieties (especially basil!), borage, spinach, lettuce,

Not Friendly:

Kohlrabi, corn, potato, dill (when mature will stunt growth), cabbage, beets,



Squash

Friendly:

Corn, squash, marigolds, legumes/beans, Dill, radish, peas

Not Friendly:

Potato, fennel



Carrots

Friendly:

Alliums (especially spring onions), Bean, lettuce, onion, pea, pepper, radish, tomato, marigold, sage, rosemary (most solanaceae)

Not Friendly:

Dill, parsnips, coriander (cilantro),



Sweet Corn

Friendly:

Beans/peas/legumes, squash and melon varieties, marigolds, nasturtiums

Not Friendly:

Tomatoes, solanaceae varieties, other corn varieties,



Onions

Friendly:

Beet, cabbage family, carrot, chard, lettuce, pepper, strawberry, tomato, parsnips

Not Friendly:

Asparagus, beans, peas



Lettuce

Friendly:

Beet, cabbage family, carrot, onion, radish, strawberry, alliums, marigolds

Not Friendly:

parsley



Potatoes

Friendly:

Beans, cabbage family, corn, eggplant, pea, marigolds

Not Friendly:

Other solanaceae family unless used for trap cropping, onion, fennel, carrots (other root crops)

**recommended to covercrop for at least a year after potato planting, do not replant the following year, plant another crop



Celery, celeriac

Friendly:

Bean, cabbage family and tomato varieties, spinach, alliums, nasturtiums

Not Friendly:

parsley, parsnips, turnips, carrots



Eggplants

Friendly:

Beans, peppers, marigolds, okra, tarragon, thyme, basil (most herbs), spinach, potatoes are okay (trial and error)

Not Friendly:

Fennel
