The workshops are geared to produce and diversified livestock producers who are new to managing employees, and to farmers who are considering changes to how they arrange for, and manage, labor on their farms. Women farmers' learning needs and priorities are integrated throughout the series.

Sessions include:

- **Practical Communication Tools for Employee Management** (Jan. 19 & 26): Learn effective management practices that can improve employee performance, and learn how to use an online tool to generate a customized policy manual for your farm.
- **Building Successful Work Teams:** Identify your communication and management preferences and practical ways to use them to build a successful crew for the coming season. (Feb. 1)
- **Hiring and Retaining Employees on Your Farm:** From job descriptions to feedback methods, strategies to optimize employee performance. (Feb. 9 & 16)

- **Planning Your Payroll:** Estimating employee costs and trade-offs with mechanization (Feb. 23 and March 2)
- **The Art of Negotiation:** Negotiation basics, with a focus on labor management. (Mar 8 & 15)
- **Cultivating a Safe, Health & Productive Crew:** Training employees on safety and ergonomics that support season-long productivity (Apr. 5 & 12)
