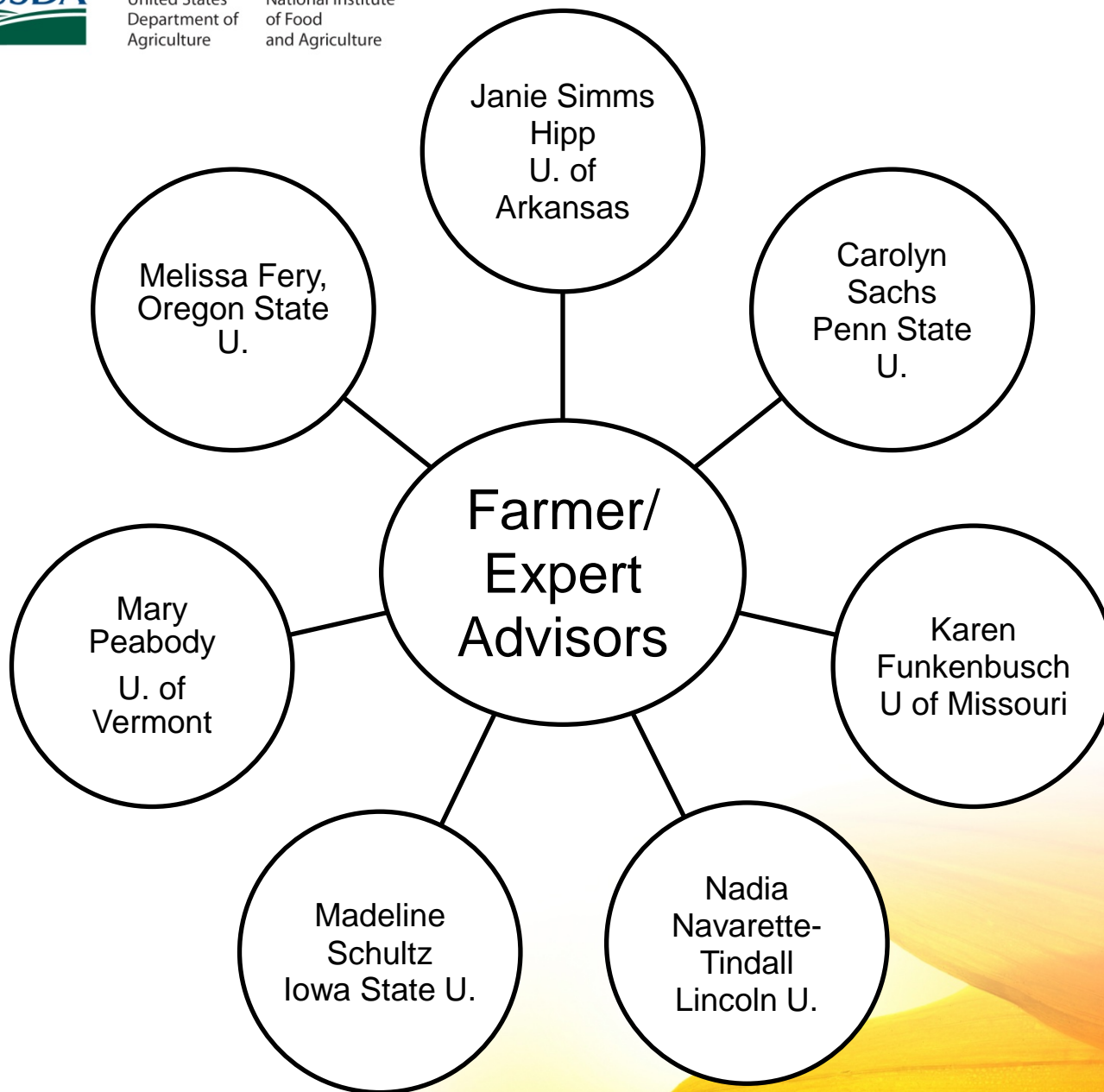

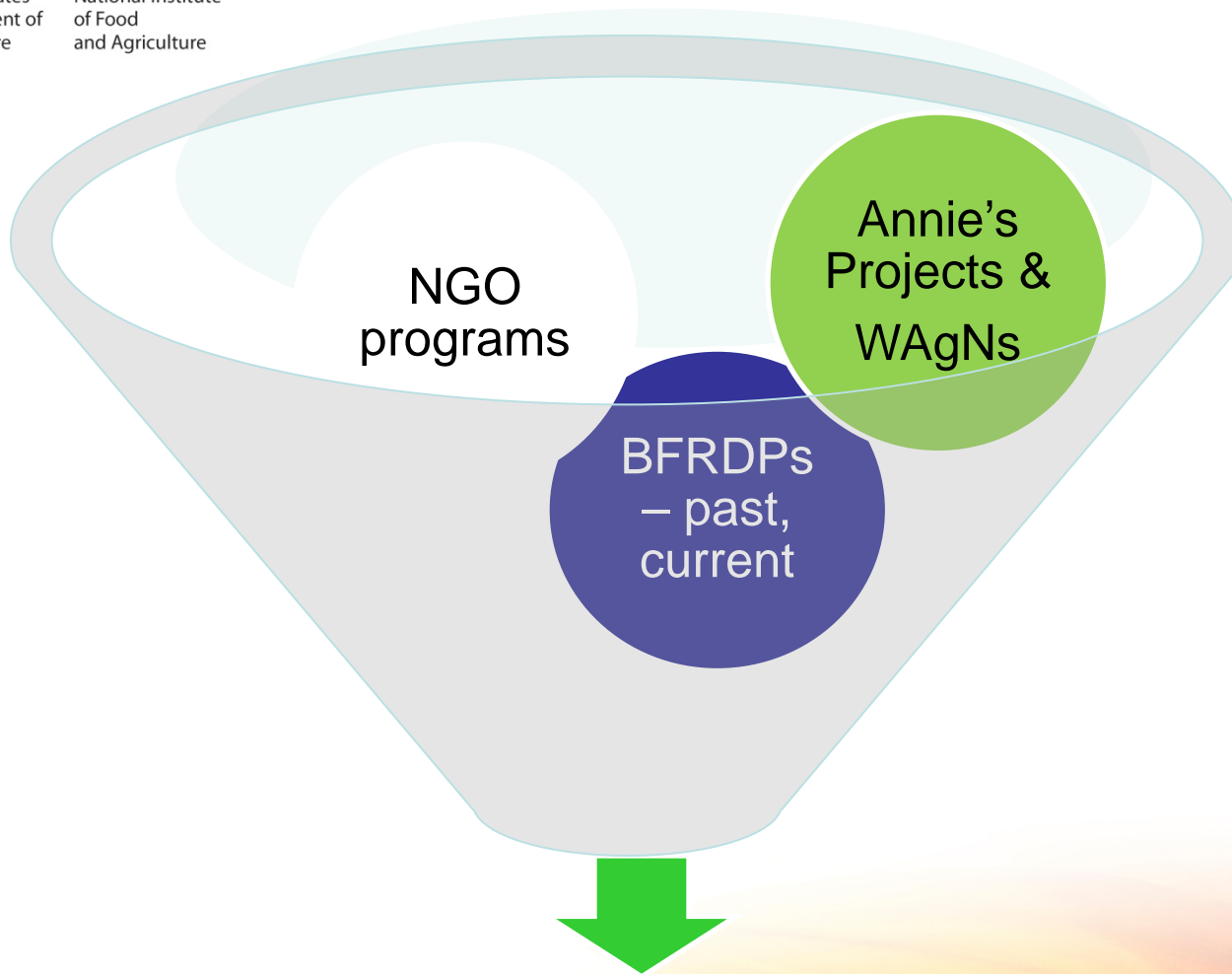

Objective 2 Impact
